



Having correctly sized images on your website helps improve the user experience.

When images are low-quality, pixelated, or too small, they can impact the perceived quality of your content. This could lead to clients questioning the quality of your business.

Conversely, high-quality, correctly sized images deliver more visual information to potential clients.

JPEG or PNG?

JPEG (or JPG) is one of the most widely used digital image file formats because it offers a balance between file size and image quality. However, JPEG uses lossy compression, which means some image quality is lost when the image is compressed.

PNG is a lossless compression format, meaning it reduces file size without sacrificing image quality. While PNGs often have larger file sizes than JPEGs, their ability to retain their clarity makes them suitable for detailed graphics and logos.

Landscape or Portrait?

It's something that gets overlooked an awful lot, but it's always best to provide landscape pictures - not portrait. We kindly ask that you please submit landscape photos.

If you have beautiful photos, but it's in portrait, you are welcome to place two/three portraits next to each other and save it as a new landscape image (not recommended for the Snapshot and Slider gallery)

We recommend a 1600 x 1067px size photo. If you are unsure if your photo is the right size, please see steps on the next page which will help you.

When will my photos get rejected?

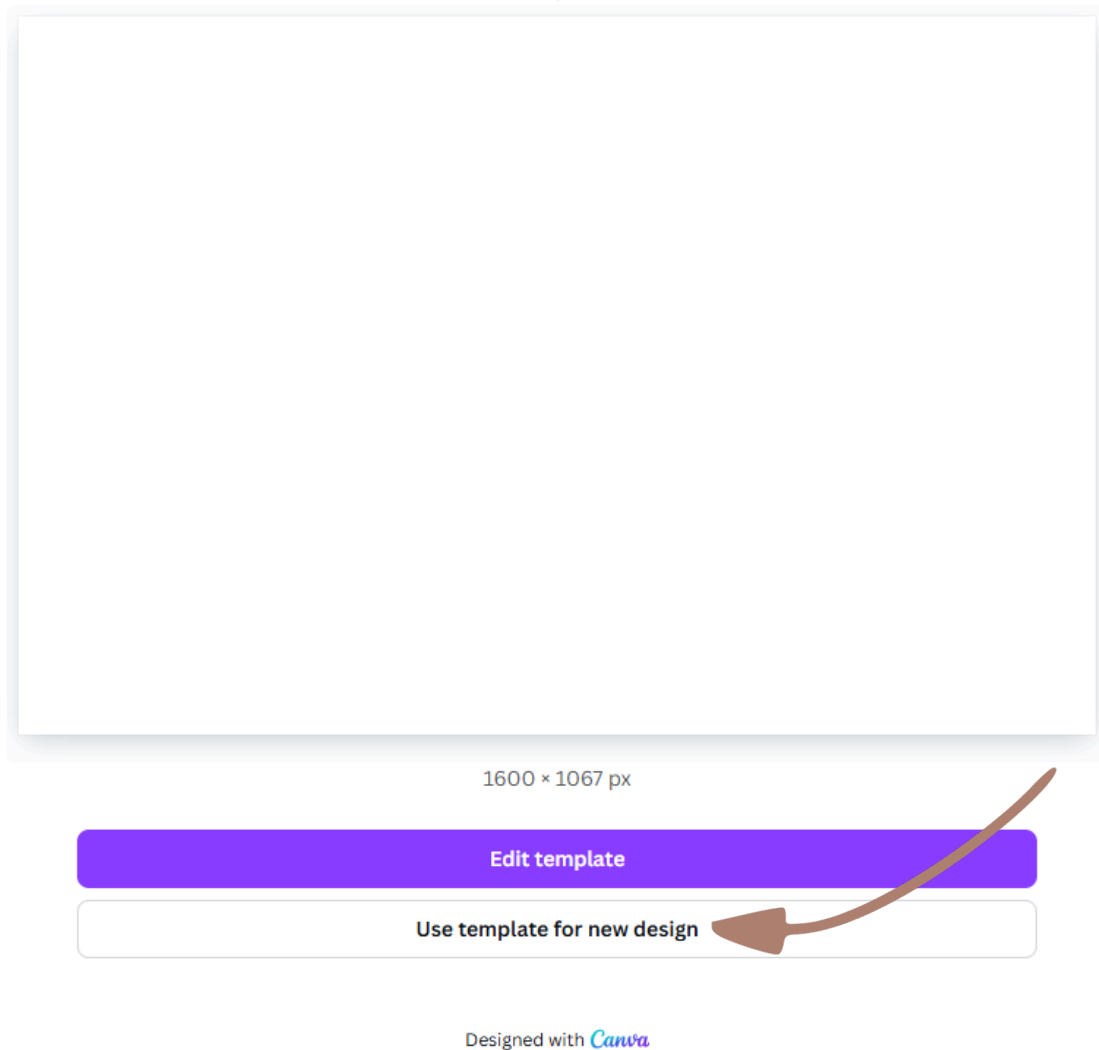
- When you upload screenshots
- Non-Professional looking photos
- Low quality, pixelated photos
- Portrait orientation
- Photos with watermarks from the internet
- Photos not relevant to the tag
- Photos with logo's and text

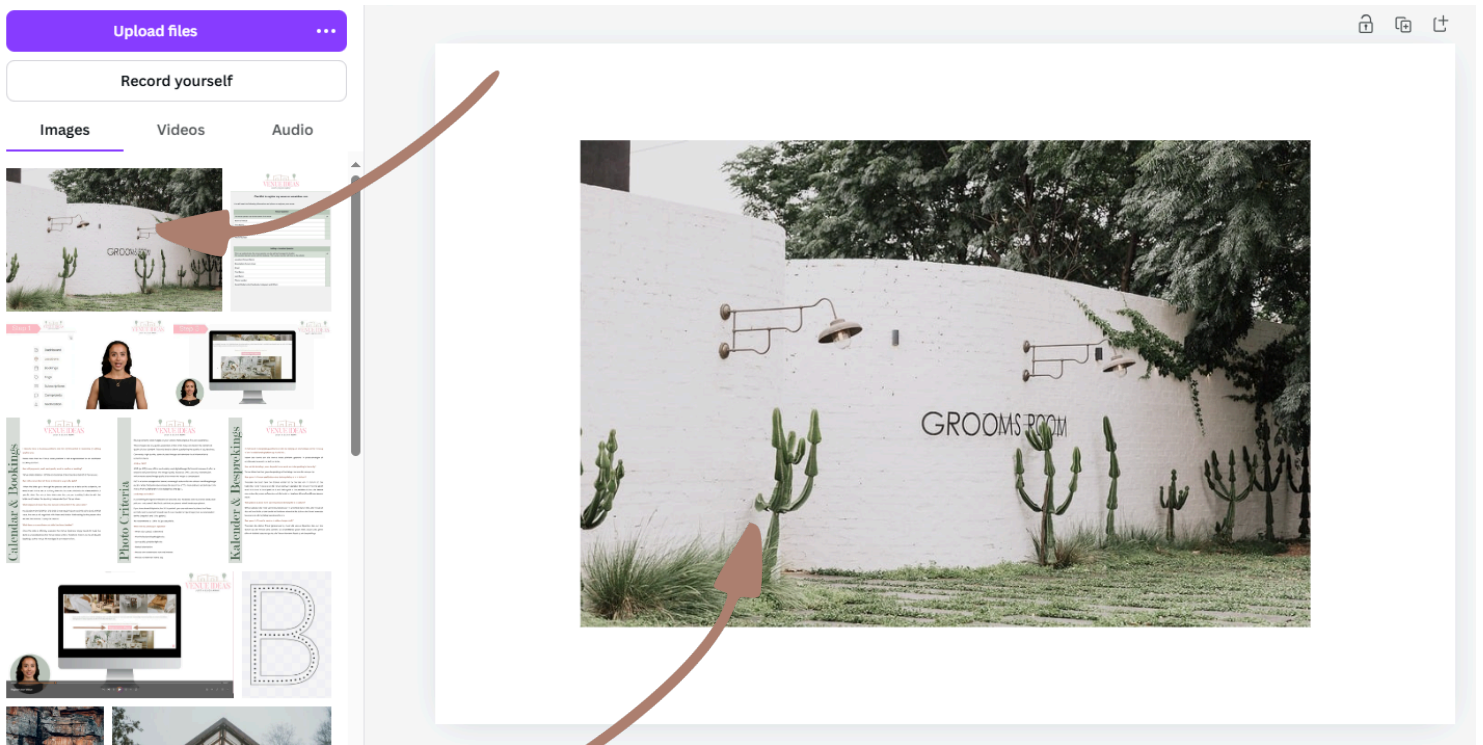


Step 3: Upload your photo(s)

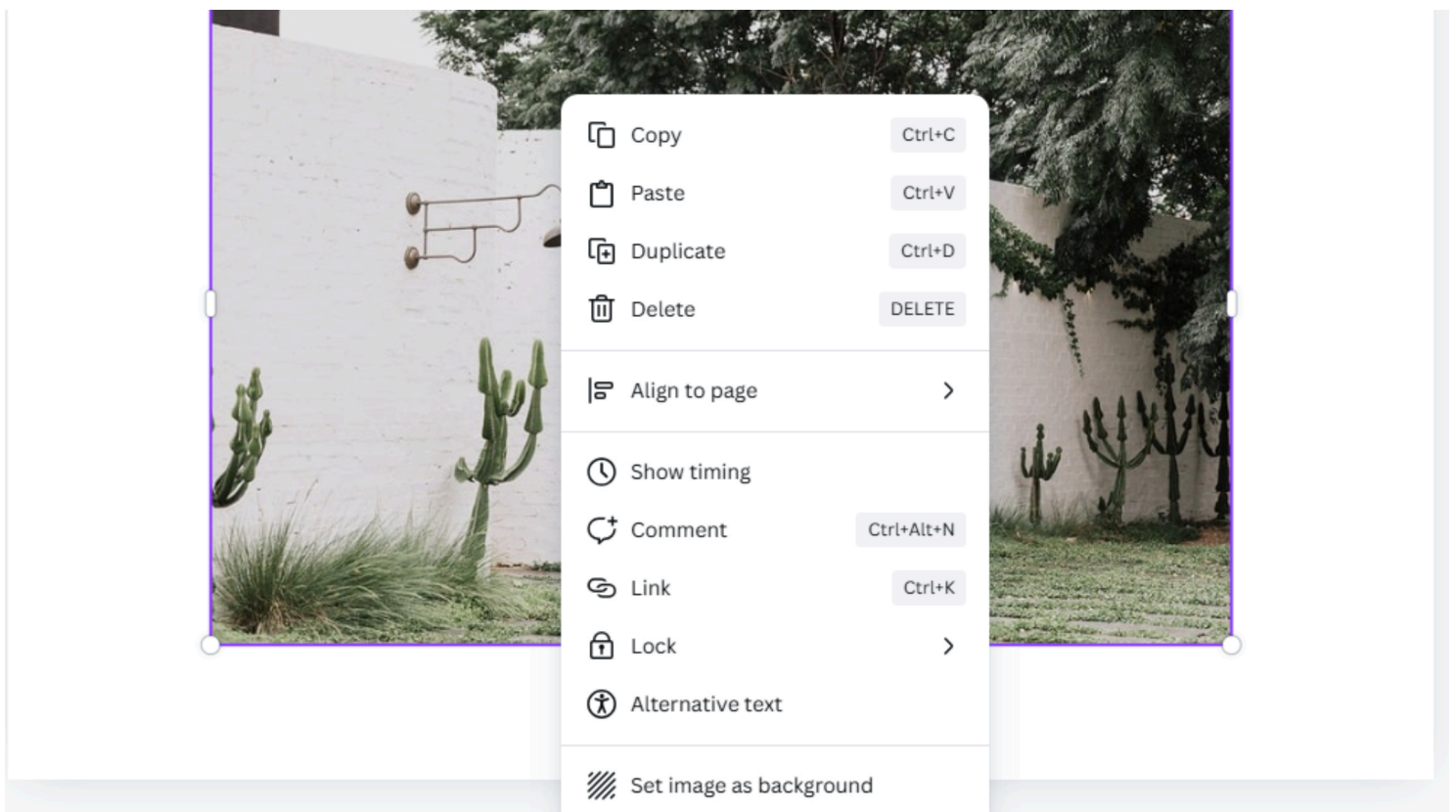

Step 4: Click on your uploaded photo on the left.

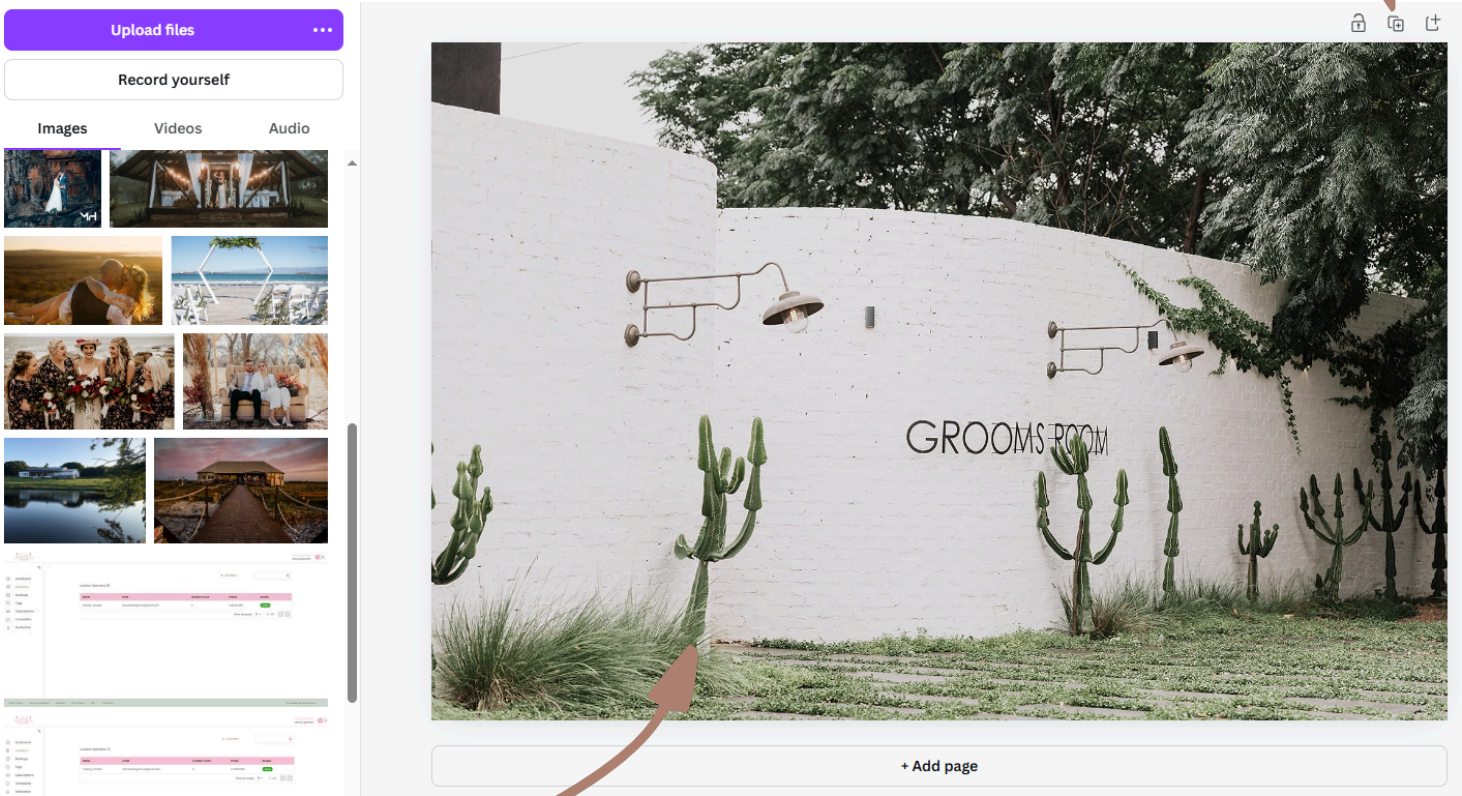


Step 5: Right click on your photo and select “Set Image as background”



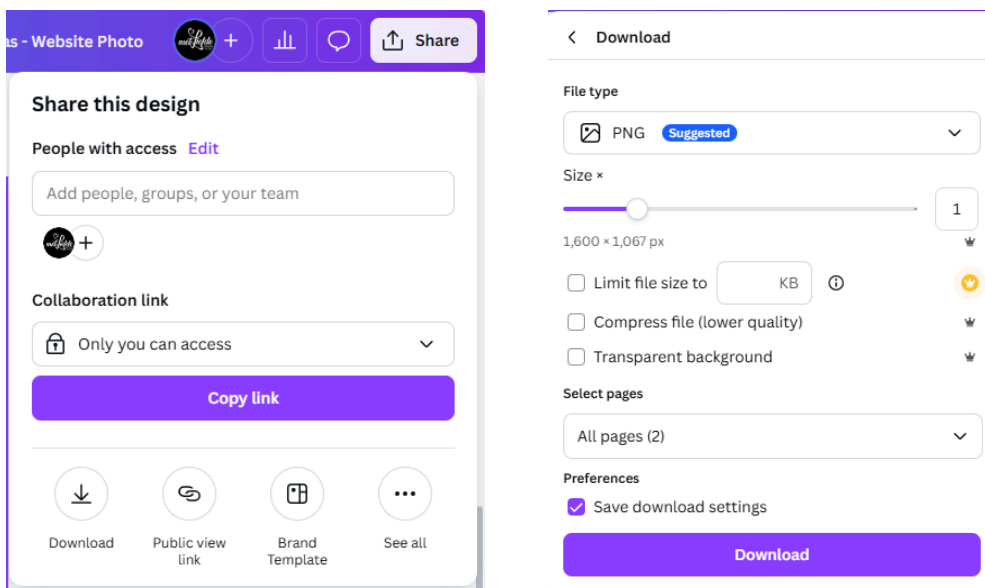

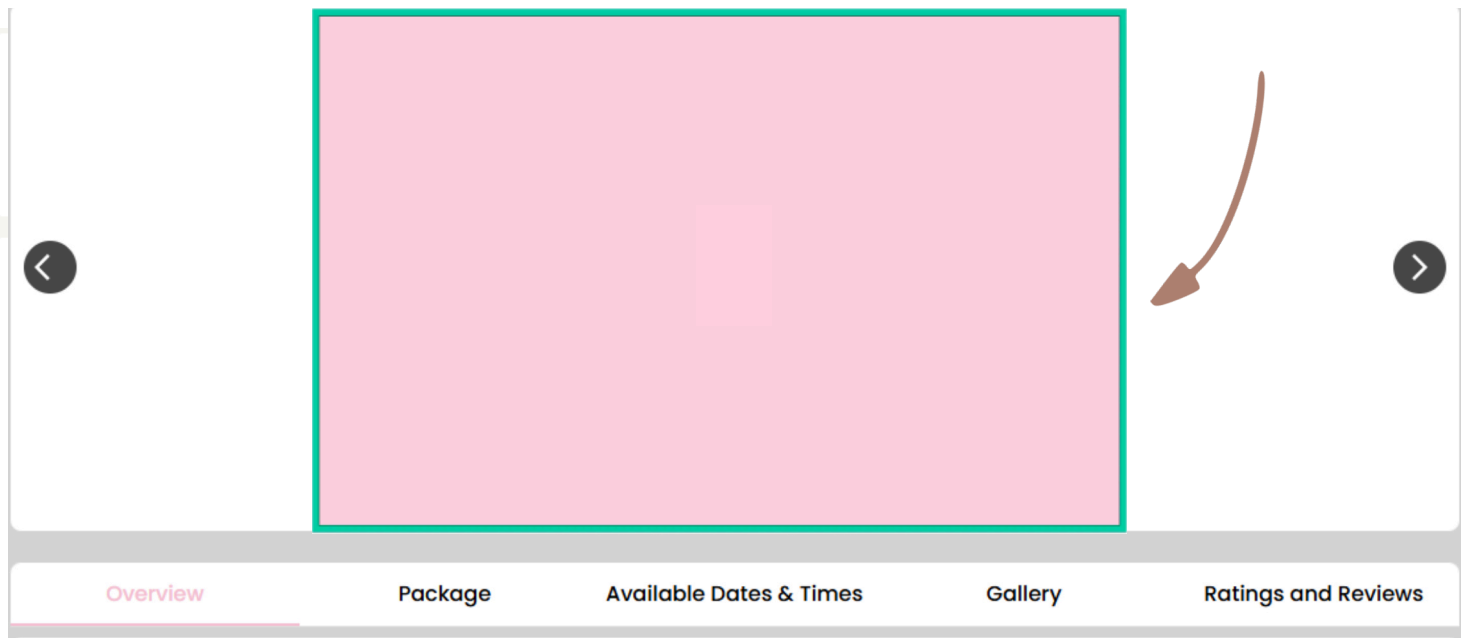

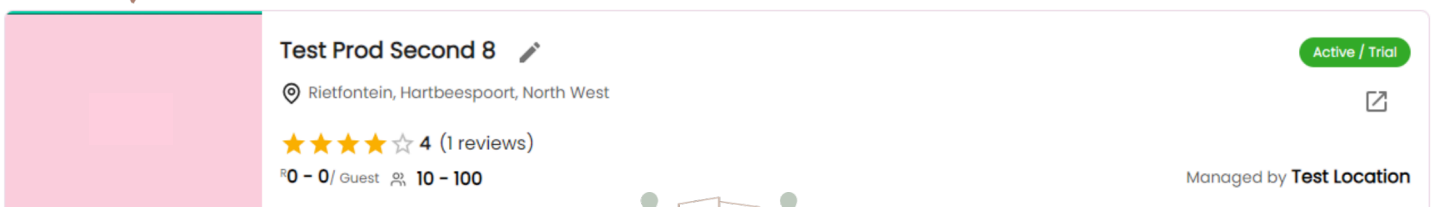
